

VISILITE[®] Care and Maintenance Instructions

Vinyl may easily scratch; please exercise caution when working with the material. When cutting, sewing, or sealing, make certain that all surfaces are clean and smooth. Vinyl should be cleaned regularly to remove dirt. Abrasive cleaners cannot be used on window vinyl.

Cleaning

Cleaning should be done with a mild vinyl cleaner or basic mild soap, such as Ivory or Lux, mixed with lukewarm water. Rinse thoroughly with water and dry using a soft microfiber towel or air dry.

Storage

Vinyl windows and curtains are best stored rolled up and dry. They should not be folded (creased) or stored for an extended period of time when damp or wet, as this may produce wrinkles, waves, or a cloudy appearance in the vinyl. If any of these problems occur, please immediately perform the actions detailed below to help restore the vinyl windows or curtains.

Important

Never use detergents, Windex[®], Rain-X[®], Pledge[®], Plexus[®], Simple Green[®], OrPine, or any other harsh cleaner. Never use a car wax or any kind of wash and wax protectant. Never use cleaners, polishes, scratch removers, or any products intended for commercial-grade vinyl or plastic.

Removing Cloudy Appearance, Wrinkles, or Waves:

Any whiteness or clouding that develops from storing wet vinyl curtains will gradually disappear when the window or curtain is deployed and exposed to sunlight (heat). Likewise, any wrinkles or waves that develop from rolling or folding your vinyl will also disappear when exposed to sunlight and heat.

You can speed this process up with a heat gun or hair dryer. Do not overheat or concentrate heat in one area for an extended period of time.
